Sometimes teens cannot live with their parents through the growing-up years. Many of UMHC's youth have been abandoned, abused, assaulted or worse. Most were removed

from unsafe environments by county agencies. Some were placed in foster care and, for many reasons, did not thrive. At UMHC, youth live in a family-like atmosphere that inspires them to hope, heal, grow, and succeed in today's complex world.

Youth receive:

- safe housing,
- healthy food,
- new clothing and shoes,
- transportation to local schools,
- educational support,
- medical and behavioral healthcare,
- life skills training,
- counseling with professional staff, and
- recreational opportunities.

UMHC was founded in 1917 by the Central Pennsylvania Conference of the Methodist Church as an orphanage. Over the decades, UMHC adapted its delivery model and now serves kids ages 12-20 using a collaborative, trauma-informed approach to care.

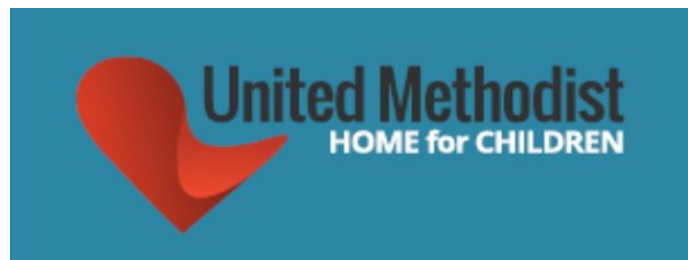
UMHC is a respected member of the Pennsylvania Council for Children, Youth and Family Services.
